

Optomap Retinal Exam

Dr. Rosanna LaMalva and her associates prefer to adhere to the voluntary standard of periodic widefield observation of the retina by capturing a widefield retinal image for review, baseline purposes, and comparison in the future. Our doctors have discovered many important health conditions that would have been missed without following these proper procedures during examinations of the eye. Our doctor's main goal is to protect the gift of sight. Annual eye examinations not only allow your eye doctor to improve the quality of your vision by changing the prescription of your glasses, but also provide the opportunity to determine the overall health of your eye from the clear window of the eye (the cornea) to the very back of the eye (the retina).

In most cases, a patient's health insurance (not vision) will cover the cost of the Optomap Retinal Exam. However, on occasion, there are circumstances that will cause an insurance company to deny a claim (such as a deductible not being met, etc.). If this occurs, the patient will then become responsible for \$35, paid to the doctor's office, to cover the cost of the digital retinal image.
